Proverbs 15:29


The LORD is far from the wicked: but he heareth the prayer of the righteous.

- 1) **The horn of the righteous shall be exalted.**
Ps 75:10 ...but the horns of the righteous shall be exalted.
- 2) **The righteous will be blessed with favour.**
Ps 5:12 For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.
- 3) **The haters of the righteous shall be desolate.**
Ps 34:21 Evil shall slay the wicked: and they that hate the righteous shall be desolate.
- 4) **The righteous shall inherit the land.**
Ps 37:29 The righteous shall inherit the land, and dwell therein for ever.
- 5) **The mouth of the righteous shall be filled with words of wisdom.**
Ps 37:30 The mouth of the righteous speaketh wisdom, and his tongue talketh of judgment.
- 6) **The righteous shall be rewarded of their righteousness.**
Ps 58:11 So that a man shall say, Verily there is a reward for the righteous
- 7) **The righteous shall flourish, and have abundance of peace.**
Ps 72:7 In his days shall the righteous flourish; and abundance of peace so long as the moon endureth.
- 8) **The righteous shall flourish like a palm tree.**
Ps 92:12 The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon.
- 9) **The righteous shall have inner light to see secret things.**
Ps 97:11 Light is sown for the righteous, and gladness for the upright in heart.
- 10) **The legacy of the righteous shall for ever be indelible.**
Ps 112:6 Surely he shall not be moved for ever: the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance.
- 11) **The hypocrisy of the wicked will not overcome the righteous.**
Ps 125:3 For the rod of the wicked shall not rest upon the lot of the righteous; lest the righteous put forth their hands unto iniquity.
- 12) **The righteous are already delivered from trouble even before they enter it.**
Pro. 11:8 The righteous is delivered out of trouble, and the wicked cometh in his stead.
- 13) **The children of the righteous are safe from troubles.**
Pro. 11:21 Though hand join in hand, the wicked shall not be unpunished: but the seed of the righteous shall be delivered.

- 14) **The desire of the righteous is purely good.**
Pro 11:23 The desire of the righteous is only good: but the expectation of the wicked is wrath.
Pro 12:5 The thoughts of the righteous are right: but the counsels of the wicked are deceit.
- 15) **The root of the righteous shall be deep beyond uprooting.**
Pro. 12:3 A man shall not be established by wickedness: but the root of the righteous shall not be moved.
- 16) **The home or name of the righteous shall be immortalised.**
Pro. 12:7 The wicked are overthrown, and are not: but the house of the righteous shall stand.
- 17) **The righteous are bound to excel.**
Pro. 12:26 The righteous is more excellent than his neighbour: but the way of the wicked seduceth them.
- 18) **There can never be mutual relationship between the righteous and the unrighteous.**
Pro. 13:5 A righteous man hateth lying: but a wicked man is loathsome, and cometh to shame.
- 19) **The righteous shall always be repayed with the good they do.**
Pro. 13:21 Evil pursueth sinners: but to the righteous good shall be repayed.
- 20) **The hope of the righteous always goes up yonder.**
Pro. 14:32 The wicked is driven away in his wickedness: but the righteous hath hope in his death.
- 21) **The highly placed men always have confidence in the advice of the righteous.**
Pro. 16:13 Righteous lips are the delight of kings; and they love him that speaketh right.
- 22) **The name of the Lord is a safe abode only for the righteous.**
Pro. 18:10 The name of the LORD is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe.
- 23) **A righteous child is a child of gladness to his parent.**
Pro. 23:24 The father of the righteous shall greatly rejoice: and he that begetteth a wise child shall have joy of him.
- 24) **The righteous will always be confident in the face of terror.**
Pro. 28:1 The wicked flee when no man pursueth: but the righteous are bold as a lion.
- 25) **It shall always be well with the righteous.**
Isa 3:10 Say ye to the righteous, that it shall be well with him: for they shall eat the fruit of their doings.
