



SIX DESTINY HELPERS MOSTLY NEEDED FOR LIFE FULFILMENT

1. Breakthrough Connectors

- **Gen 41:1-42 (9,& 41 9)** Then spake the chief butler unto Pharaoh, saying, I do remember my faults this day: 41 And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, See, I have set thee over all the land of Egypt.
- **Lessons from this story:**
 - i) **Joseph was in the prison, and met a destiny helper.**
 - You can meet your destiny helper anywhere and in any condition.
 - ii) **Joseph interpreted a dream for him and nothing was given in returns.**
 - When you render a service for anyone, expect no appreciation, but mind you a seed has already been sown.
 - iii) **The chief butler remembered Joseph when another problem arose. Gen 41:9**
 - Be happy if people remember you only when they have problems, respond with joy, because you have created a pathway to breakthrough connection!
 - iv) **The gift of Joseph was as same as it was two years ago. Gen 41:1**
 - Ensure sin or worldly pleasures did not destroy your gift because it is the platform of your breakthrough sooner or later.

2. Ladder Holders

- **Mark 2:2-5 (4-5)** 4 And when they could not come nigh unto him for the press, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken it up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy lay. 5 When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee. (KJV)
- **Lessons from this story:**
 - i) **The helpers were four men who combined efforts together.**
 - Your destiny helpers (at times) could be a group of people.
 - ii) **The four men were harmonised. Mark 2:3**
 - True group of ladder holders should always be united.
 - iii) **They broke the roof; (don't forget) they would have to repair it. Mk 2:4**
 - True Destiny helpers are always ready to break the unbroken for your help.
 - iv) **Amidst the crowd, they identified themselves with the sick man.**
 - Genuine destiny helpers are always ready to identify themselves with you and awkward situations.
 - ✓ *Anyone who is not ready to identify himself with you because of your low condition can never be your destiny helper. Detach yourself from him.*
 - v) **Jesus considered the faith of the four helpers to heal the sick. Mark 2:5**
 - God can consider the efforts of your destiny helpers to raise you.

3.) The all-in-all Destiny Helpers

- **Job 29 15-16** I was eyes to the blind, and feet was I to the lame. **16** I was a father to the poor: and the cause which I knew not I searched out.
- Being eyes to the blind means: he would help you to see things you didn't see
- Being feet to the lame means: *he would go ahead to speak for you where you couldn't reach.*
- Father to the poor: he would be ready to do what your parents could not to do for you.

4) Informative Destiny Helpers

- **I Sam 30:11-16 (15)** And David said to him, Canst thou bring me down to this company? And he said, Swear unto me by God, that thou wilt neither kill me, nor deliver me into the hands of my master, and I will bring thee down to this company.
- **Lessons from this story:**
 - i) God may cause your destiny helper to sick, hence he needs care.**
 - True care is a sure way to connect a destiny helper.
 - ii) Your destiny helper may want you to protect his identity.**
 - Do not thank a destiny helper over benevolence in the midst of people. Do not expose him to danger!
 - ✓ **He who knows how to protect a destiny helper can maintain a lasting relationship with him.**

5) Angelic Destiny Helpers

- **Gen 31:10** And it came to pass at the time that the cattle conceived, that I lifted up mine eyes, and saw in a dream, and, behold, the rams which leaped upon the cattle were ringstraked, speckled, and grised.
- **Lessons from this story:**
 - i) Laban suffered Jacob because he was highly destined.**
 - People you work with may tactically enslave you if they see that you have greater fortunes.
 - ii) At fourteen years in the business of Laban, Jacob could not bear the situation anymore.**
 - When the Spirit of God is stirring you to do something, that's the best time to act. **Gen 30:37-41**
 - iii) Jacob took step, God helped him.**
 - God is ready to help you, the moment you are ready for the help!
 - iv) Amazingly, Jacob dreamed, angel of God revealed what he needed to do to him.**
 - Pray until the angel of your destiny helper appears to you in the dream.

When the Spirit of God is stirring you to do something, that's the best time to act.

6) Vision Financiers

- **Job 29: 12-13** Because I delivered the poor that cried, and the fatherless, and him that had none to help him. **13** The blessing of him that was ready to perish came upon me: and I caused the widow's heart to sing for joy.
- **Job 29: 15-16** I was eyes to the blind, and feet was I to the lame. **16** I was a father to the poor: and the cause which I knew not I searched out.

The meaning of these verses:

i) "I delivered the poor and the fatherless that cried"

- If the penniless visionary can cry to God in prayers, God will raise vision financier for him.
- Vision financier that will put praises, joy and gladness to their mouth.
- Vision financier that will be all-in-all for them.
